Update report from Chairman Councillor Colin Noakes

Days are getting shorter and the temperature is getting cooler, winter is only around the corner. Consequently, APC can confirm that the warm space in the library meeting room will again be provided this year, from the 7.10.2024. With increased energy bills and some pensioners losing their heating allowance, this will be a welcome addition to the village's warm space provision, which is already provided by a number of organisations. Therefore, if you would like a cup of tea or coffee in warm, friendly surroundings, please come to the library.

Remembrance Sunday is the 10th November 2024. This is the first one since the war memorials renovation and we are hoping for a

big turn out from residents to pay their respects. APC will be providing light refreshments at the Red House following the parade and church service. All are welcome to attend.

I can confirm that following the full Council meeting on the 3rd October 2024 APC approved grants to Say Yes (a youth organisation), Citizens Advice Bureau, St Mary's Church and St Mary's CoE PTA. If there are any community organisations out there which require funding for specific projects, then please submit an application form. APC will be pleased to consider all grant applications and help where it is able to.

We have had another meeting with Donington and Boscobel Councillors regarding the merging of the two Councils. We now have a number of questions that require legal advice, and we are awaiting answers to our enquiries. This is a very complicated process but we are confident that we will all be ready for 1st April 2025 when the new Council will take over.
